Locate the "Settings" icon and press it.



Click the "Wi-Fi" tab under "Settings".



If the Wi-Fi is turned "Off", swipe the grey toggle to the right to scan for available Wi-Fi networks. Once enabled, the Wi-Fi locator displays available networks within range of your iPad.



Find "#SFWiFi" in the list of networks and click on the blue arrow to connect.



Once the connection is established, a blue checkmark displays next to "#SFWiFi" and the network's name turns blue.
