



# Wi-Fi guide for iPhone

1 Locate the "Settings" icon and press it.



2 Click on the "Wi-Fi" tab under "Settings".



3 If your Wi-Fi settings have been turned "Off", swipe the button to the right to scan for available Wi-Fi connections.



4 Find "#SFWiFi" in the list of networks and click the blue arrow to connect.



5 Once the connection is established, a blue checkmark displays next to "#SFWiFi" and the network's name turns blue.



6 To connect to the internet, open a web browser and type a website address.

7 The San Francisco FREE WIFI web page opens. From this page, you can access the service terms and conditions.



8 You will now be logged into San Francisco's complimentary Wi-Fi service.



# Wi-Fi guide for iPad

- 1 Locate the "Settings" icon and press it.
- 2 Click the "Wi-Fi" tab under "Settings".
- 3 If the Wi-Fi is turned "Off", swipe the grey toggle to the right to scan for available Wi-Fi networks. Once enabled, the Wi-Fi locator displays available networks within range of your iPad.
- 4 Find "#SFWiFi" in the list of networks and click on the blue arrow to connect.
- 5 Once the connection is established, a blue checkmark displays next to "#SFWiFi" and the network's name turns blue.
- 6 To connect to the internet, open a web browser and type a website address.
- 7 The San Francisco FREE WiFi web page opens. From this page, you can access the service terms and conditions.
