Employees, more than 1000, from Departments* across the city have made pledges to the charitable organizations of their choice through the Campaign. These pledges, plus future ones, support charitable organizations to find solutions to our local community problems; strengthen communities by building financial resources and improving individual and organizational capacity; fight life-threatening illnesses and diseases while improving the quality of life for patients and their families; protect, support and improve California's natural heritage of clean air, safe water, diverse wildlife and healthy communities and families; create change through harnessing the power of nonprofits, government, corporations and thousands of individuals; as well as make tangible differences in the lives of our most vulnerable citizens.

Through the City and County of San Francisco's Heart of the City Combined Charities Campaign, current employees and retirees can participate by donating through payroll deductions or making a one-time donation to various charities through the unique partnership we have with seven federations representing a host of charitable organizations. Contributions can also be made through the Donor's Choice option to an IRS recognized 501(c)(3) non-profit organization - which is not represented by one of our partnering federations.
