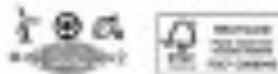

The Asian Pacific Fund is a non-profit foundation dedicated to **strengthening the Bay Area's Asian and Pacific Islander (API) communities**. Since 1993, we have been committed to increasing philanthropy and supporting organizations that provide vital services to the most vulnerable members of our community. We also shed light on the hidden challenges that Bay Area APIs face, including:

- Four out of the five ethnic groups with the highest rates of poverty in the Bay Area are API.
- From 2007 to 2012, API poverty grew by 43% in San Francisco—more than any other racial group.
- APIs are 39% of all households living in subsidized housing in Santa Clara County and 33% in San Francisco, the highest of any other racial group.

APIs make up over 26 percent of the Bay Area population. Many are newer immigrants and refugees who face poverty, isolation, limited access to healthcare and other challenges. Despite the high level of need that exists within our community, non-profits who serve the API community receive less than 1 percent of foundation funding in the Bay Area.

The Asian Pacific Fund has distributed nearly \$6,000,000 million in grants and scholarships to the Bay Area API community. Our grants support strengthening infrastructure for member organizations or help fund direct services to our most vulnerable community members...low income limited English speaking immigrants.

Here are just some of the services our member organizations provide:

- Legal services and/or advocacy for low income workers' rights, affordable housing and other immigrant needs
- Job training skills and low cost childcare
- Culturally competent domestic violence assistance including in-language telephone hotline, counseling and temporary shelter
- Medical services at a free community clinic that serves low-income and LGBTQI Asian residents in the Tenderloin
- Leadership training, social services and mentoring for at-risk youth and juveniles on probation
- Assistance, meals and activities for Asian seniors and the home-bound elderly
- ESL, civics classes and citizenship application assistance

In addition to supporting member organizations, the Asian Pacific Fund raises awareness of API needs to other foundations and promotes philanthropy within the Bay Area Asian community.
