**\*P3a. Description:** (Describe resource and its major elements. Include design, materials, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries.)

This building is set on an urban lot, measuring 23 feet wide by 100 feet deep, in San Francisco's Inner Mission neighborhood. It is located on the north side of Sycamore Street between Valencia and Mission Streets, with the primary façade facing Sycamore. It is built to the front lot line, with no setback, and extends north to the rear lot line fronting Clarion Alley.

This is a rectangular plan, two-story commercial building with a flat roof, clad in heavily textured stucco. Asbestos shingles are visible as cladding on the west façade. A physical therapy office occupies the building. The first floor façade is dominated by a metal roll-up garage door at the center, flanked by two metal entry doors. Four one-over-one wood double-hung windows are located in a band at the second floor. Some tie-rod anchor plates are visible on the façade. The projecting cornice is unadorned.

With its heavy stucco cladding, which likely replaced the original cladding and also covered or replaced any original stylistic details, this building appears to be altered without a distinct style.
