Transitions Clinic is an innovative program that provides comprehensive primary care services and a medical home for individuals with chronic diseases, who have been recently released from state or federal prison or incarcerated in jail. Services are covered by Medi-Cal (health insurance). There are over 14 active TCN Programs throughout California.



We believe that individuals with a history of incarceration:

- *Should be treated with respect*
- *Should have services specifically tailored to their needs*
- *Have a right to confidential services*
- *Have the ability to make decision about their own healthcare*

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Community Health Workers (CHWs), who also have a history of incarceration, guide our patients through the transition out of prison and navigation of the healthcare system. CHWs can help with the following:

- Medical insurance enrollment
- Medical appointments
- Mental health and substance use service navigation
- Housing, employment, education, legal and social service referrals
- Access to food
- Family reconciliation
- Transportation
- Other health and reentry support
