The Committee's mission is to undertake this work recognizing individual human rights and promoting a universal standard of care for shelters and resource centers in the City and County of San Francisco.

What we do:

- Conduct site inspections
- Take complaints through community outreach, a hotline, e-mail, and walk-in hours
- Write reports with recommendations to the Mayor's Office and Board of Supervisors
- Investigate Standard of Care complaints

What we don't do:

- Oversee shelters or resource centers
- Make shelter reservations
- o Provide advocacy and counseling services
