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ORDER OF DETERMINATION

DOMINIC MAIONCHI v. RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT (09032)

FACTS OF THE CASE

Dominic Maionchi made a Public Records Request for the address of slip holders who have signed contracts with the Recreation and Park Department. Dominic Maionchi received word from the department that it would be redacting the mailing addresses of the slip holders.

COMPLAINT FILED

Dominic Maionchi filed a complaint against the department alleging that the department violated Section 67.24 of the Sunshine Ordinance on June 18, 2009.

HEARING ON THE COMPLAINT

On July 28, 2009, complainant Dominic Maionchi appeared before the Task Force and presented his claim. Respondent Agency was represented by Olive Gong of the Recreation and Park Department.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Task Force found that addresses must be released, and only withheld if it pertained to whistle-blower and retribution issues.

DECISION AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION

The Task Force finds that the agency violated Section 67.24 for withholding information and Sec 67.27 for not providing justification for the withholding. The agency shall

release the records requested within 5 business days of the issuance of this Order and appear before the Compliance and Amendments Committee on September 8, 2009.
