5. **File No. 23053:** Complaint filed by Sergei Severinov against the Police Department for allegedly violating the Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21(b), by failing to respond to a public records request in a timely and/or complete manner. (00:38:10)

Sergie Severinov (Petitioner) provided a summary of the status of his complaint. Mr. Severinov commented on the corrupt and racist actions of the Police Department and the Chief of Police Chief. Mr. Severinov stated and that the public records requested will prove that these allegations are true. Mr. Severinov requested computer aided dispatch

numbers, police reports, and footage identified as computer numbers. Mr. Severinov stated that no police reports, records or records of police units have been received.

Lt. Christopher Beauchamp (Police Department, Respondent) provided a summary of the department's position. Lt. Beauchamp stated that the computer aided dispatch numbers were provided on February 24, 2022. Lt. Beauchamp stated that he could provide criminal records. Lt. Beauchamp also stated that the department cannot provide body worn camera footage unless there is use of force data and suggested that he request those records from the Department of Emergency Management. Lt. Beauchamp stated that his department is still reviewing responses and requests made by Mr. Severinov.

A question and answer period occurred. The parties were provided an opportunity for rebuttals.

Action: Moved by Chair LaHood, seconded by Member Wolfe, requesting that in regard to request No. 1 that Lt. Beauchamp return to the next meeting and provide within five days the body worn camera file with redactions keyed or assigned with the code or the law that could verify that each of those redactions and if any item should be unredacted, provide the code explaining why matter was redacted. In addition, the Committee requests that Lt. Beauchamp work with the Police Department's IT Department to retrieve the requested information and send it to Mr. Severinov. In regard to request No. 2, the Committee requests that Lt. Beauchamp supply the records of the phone calls managed by the parties in items 22 and 23 for the dates and times requested, confirm when the request has been sent to the City IT department and a response has been received.
