You now have the Order of Determination: https://sfgov.org/sunshine/sites/default/files/SOTF_ORDER_19112.pdf

You have 5 days to comply, pursuant to the Sunshine Ordinance, and also SOTF Complaint Rule E1.

As you know, we will request that SOTF, on Oct. 7, which will be 6 business days after this Order was published, find each of you in willful violation of the Ordinance sec. 67.26 for failing to provide Chief Scott's future calendar entries (instead of minimally redacting them), pursuant to sec. 67.34. With respect to Chief Scott, we will ask that his willful noncompliance be referred to the Ethics Commission for an investigation into official misconduct (Sec. 67.34).

We may take any other action lawfully permitted by the Sunshine Ordinance and/or CPRA, including but not limited to request for referral by the SOTF to the District Attorney and Attorney General (sec. 67.30(c), 67.21(e)) and suit against the City, asking Superior Court to enforce the orders of the SOTF.

Note:

> "If the custodian refuses or fails to comply with any such order within 5 days, the Sunshine Task Force shall notify the district attorney or the attorney general who may take whatever measures she or he deems necessary to insure compliance with the provisions of this ordinance. "

We once again demand the release of Chief Scott's future calendars Oct. 1-14 under P013417-090620, pursuant to the now published Order of Determination 19112. You have already refused. If you wait until the date of meeting entries have passed, we will continue to ask SOTF to find you in willful violation, as that is what you did which was found to be unlawful in the original request for 19112.

The San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) received your Public Records Act request, dated September 06, 2020, on September 08, 2020.

*You requested, "SFPD and Lt. Cox, On Sept. 2, 2020, in SOTF 19112 Anonymous v. Scott, et al., SOTF found a violation by SFPD of, inter alia, SFAC 67.26 for not providing future/prospective calendars for Chief Scott at all (instead of with minimal redactions) and SFAC 67.27 for citing Prop G for withholding non-Prop G calendars. Lt. Cox also appeared to state that SFPD had changed its own position re: disclosure policies of calendars to properly disclose future and non-Prop G calendars, notwithstanding the position of the City Attorney's office. Therefore, this is an immediate disclosure request for all calendars/schedule records (with all meeting details in Outlook or anywhere else, including all attachments and metadata) for Chief William Scott (both Prop G and non-Prop G) for (a) Oct 1 through Oct 14, 2020 as the schedule exists at this time and (b) Aug 24-Sep 1, 2020 (all dates inclusive). Pursuant to SFAC 67.21(l) and SOTF 19047, please provide the records in PDF format *without* printing and scanning. Also, you mentioned that you had created a specific email address for records requests - could you please indicate what that email is? I am aware of sfpdlegal@sfgov.org and sfpdmediarelations@sfgov.org. (There are various, independent, anonymous requesters who use MuckRock - so I cannot control what the other users do, but I am happy to request MuckRock use a different email address for SFPD if it will work better.)"*

The immediate disclosure process is for requests that are "simple, routine or otherwise readily answerable." Please see San Francisco Administrative Code section 67.25(a). Your request is not simple or routine. The maximum deadline for responding to a request applies. The Department is looking into your request and will provide you with a response within 10 calendar days but no later than by September 18, 2020. Please refer to California Government Code Section 6253(c).


I am writing to clarify my responses made during the SOTF Hearing on September, 2, 2020, File No. 19112: Complaint filed by Anonymous against Chief William Scott and Lt. R. Andrew Cox and the Police Department. Specifically, I was asked by the committee if SFPD would release future Prop. G calendars upon request and I answered yes. I apologize for causing confusion. When I provided that answer, I did not mean to infer that SFPD would waive any rights to exempt Prop. G calendars in whole or any portion thereof if warranted. We continue to apply exemptions and exceptions to the Chief's future calendar entries that have not yet occurred under Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(f); Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(k); Cal. Evid. Code. § 1040; Times Mirror Company v. Superior Court, 53 Cal.3d 1325 (1991).

Chief Scott is the head Law Enforcement Official for the City and County of San Francisco, which carries a higher risk to his personal safety. His job presents unique security risks that requires unique security procedures and protocols to ensure his safety. Releasing information from his calendar reveals the timing and details of his whereabouts as well as the patterns and habits of the Chief of Police. While we are cautious to release his calendar at all under the laws cited above, we have done so after a careful review of events that have occurred in the past and redact information according to the cites listed above. However, this careful review may only be done by looking back at events that have already occurred. Releasing future calendar entries presents a new set of security issues.

Releasing future calendar entries inherently increases the risk to his security. This would seriously impair the ability of the Department to assure his personal safety and it would constitute a potential threat to his safety because this information would enable a reader to know in advance and with relative precision when and where the Chief may be found, the timing of his departures and arrivals from events or locations. In addition, the reader would know the persons who will be with him, and when he will be alone. We have redacted past Prop. G calendars entries under Cal. Govt Code section 6254(f) Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(k); Cal. Evid. Code. § 1040; Times Mirror Company v. Superior Court, 53 Cal.3d 1325 (1991).SFPD has never produced future Prop. G calendars in the past.

In retrospect, I understand that I answered the question poorly and I should have elaborated on our position. I sincerely apologize for any confusion and did not mean to mislead the committee and/or Anonymous. My statement to the committee was of my own volition and should not reflect any misconduct by Chief Scott or the SFPD.

3. SFAC 67.27 for unlawfully citing to SFAC 67.29-5 as a justification for withholding non-Prop G calendars because 67.29-5 is not an exemption to disclosure.

Your DCA states that using SOTF 19047 as direct precedent for requiring disclosure of "non-Prop G" calendars is difficult because your Motion/Order did not include a specific reasoning; I request that your motion in this case include reasoning.



Government Code Sec. 6254(c) – Personal information


Government Code Sec. 6254(f) – Law enforcement sensitive information

SOTF 19112 - Anonymous vs SFPD, Chief Scott, Lt. Cox
Petitioner's Summary as of Dec. 10, for presentation Dec. 17

Violations occurring prior to filing of complaint

- SFAC 67.21 - General untimeliness/incompleteness - SFPD admits untimeliness in their complaint response. No non-Prop G calendars provided. No future calendars provided.
- SFAC 67.26 - Non-Prop G and future calendars withheld in full instead of provided in redacted form. This is not minimal withholding.
- SFAC 67.27 - Failing to provide valid justification. SFPD used 67.29-5(a) to withhold future calendar entries. It also used 67.29-5(b,e) as exemptions. However 67.29-5 (Prop G) is merely a positive, additional duty imposed on department heads, not an exemption to the CPRA (See your DCA memo.) Prop G does not and cannot create new exemptions, it merely forces *additional, minimum* requirements on Calendars.

NOTE: Unlike the Mayor in SOTF 19103, SFPD did not use GC 6254(f) (which, while I disagree with the legal validity to exempt an entire calendar, is in fact a permitted exemption in SF) to exempt entirety of future calendars.

Violations in the same request, after filing complaint:

- After the complaint, SFPD in response to the complaint provided certain non-Prop G calendars, and changed their mind on what exemptions apply, including with future calendars. They claim their earlier response was a “miscommunication” but they clearly set out different justifications in that response than they do now. Regardless, the prior allegations are and were true as of the filing of the complaint.
- SFAC 67.26 - In the new disclosures they have made numerous impermissible redactions, engaging in non-minimal withholding. I have specified 17 examples in my supplementary letter of Nov 28.
- SFAC 67.26 - Future calendar still deemed entirely exempt instead of in redacted form.

What remains is:

- 19112 - Chief's calendars (sent to the full Task Force)
- 19098 - emails and digital communications (Dec 2019 committee hearing continued by Respondent)
- 19128 - Bryan Carmody forensics communications (pending committee)
- 19141 - failure to respond in any way to 2 IDRs (pending notice to Respondents)

As discussed, while it would be helpful to hear 19098 and 19128 together (for the convenience of SFPD since I believe Sgt. Andraychak is the contact for both) at the next committee, the legal issues in the 4 complaints are unrelated to each other so they can't really be combined without causing confusion.

After reviewing my records **I am withdrawing SOTF 19124**, but I shall file a new complaint later on for the remainder of SB 1421 police misconduct records.

ON THE USE OF EMAIL VS PORTAL

SOTF Complaint Committee asked why I don't want to use Respondents' public records portal system "GovQA." Note that I take no position on whether or not private entity GovQA's practices comport with the law, only on whether or not Respondents can force me to use the portal. On a practical note, email is much easier for me to use with the docketing system I use for records requests (MuckRock.com). I have a unique email address for each request so everything is automatically tracked and logged. Respondents' must accept emailed requests and not make GovQA the only way to get records (emphasis and footnotes mine):

- SFAC 67.21(b) states: "A custodian of a public record shall, as soon as possible and within ten days following receipt of a request for inspection or copy of a public record, comply with such request. Such request may be delivered to the office of the custodian by the requester orally or in writing by fax, postal delivery, or e-mail. ..."
- At the July 25, 2017 meeting of a Sunshine Ordinance Task Force committee hearing specifically about SFPD's use of GovQA, the SFPD represented that the public may still make requests by email. "Sgt. Youngblood stated that the public is still able to submit public records request via **email**, phone and U.S. mail but all requests are entered into the tracking system and responded to as requested by the requester."

- SFPD's public records website¹ states (Exhibit A): "Members of the public may still make requests using U.S. mail, facsimile, **email** and by phone by using the request form² (PDF). Those requests will be manually entered and tracked in the public portal by a member of the Legal staff." However, their form (Exhibit B) provides a postal and fax address, but **no email address**. I also cannot be required to use any particular form.³

³ "The California Public Records Act plainly does not require a written request." *Los Angeles Times v. Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority*, 88 Cal.App.4th 1381, 1392 (2d Dist. 2001). Since requests are not required to be in writing at all, they also cannot be required to be written in a specific way or form.

- If GovQA imposes any terms/conditions, I cannot be required to use GovQA even under the CPRA. “As a matter of first impression in California, we conclude that end user restrictions are incompatible with the purposes and operation of the CPRA.” *County of Santa Clara v. Superior Court*, 170 Cal.App.4th 1301, 1334 (Cal. Ct. App. 2009, discussing an agency purporting to impose end user restrictions related to copyright on their public records)
- SFPD cannot make a private entity the sole conduit for records and then not provide them itself (Gov Code 6270(a)).

SUPPLEMENT #1 TO COMPLAINT

On Oct 23, I alleged Respondents violated SFAC 67.21, 67.26, and 67.27 in failing to respond correctly to an Oct. 8 IDR for Chief Scott's calendar records. SOTF noticed Respondents on or around Oct. 30, and on Nov. 5, Respondents responded to SOTF. Due to further disclosures by the Respondent, I further supplement my complaint below.

AMENDED ALLEGATIONS

This supplements, and does not replace, allegations in the Oct. 23 complaint.

A. All allegations re: failure to provide future calendar dates are maintained. I continue to dispute all blanket exemptions of meetings in the future. Future meetings were originally withheld using Admin Code 67.29-5(a), which is not an exemption at all. (SFAC 67.26, 67.27). If a calendar exists at the time of a request, it is a public record, and needs to be exempt in whole or in part under a CPRA mandatory or permissive provision. Remember the Sunshine Ordinance cannot create additional exemptions, it can only limit those of the CPRA.

B. Respondent admits a timeliness violation in paragraph 2 of their Nov. 5 response to the Task Force: "The SFPD takes responsibility for not providing a response to the requestor within the required time frame." The Task Force should find a timeliness violation without further argument.

C. In response to my complaint, Respondents provided in redacted form the non-Prop G calendars previously withheld in their entirety. Respondent claims a misunderstanding, but my initial request was clear: both Prop G and non-Prop G calendars were demanded, and it made specific reference to SOTF 19047 and the Sup. of Records letter of Sept. 6 regarding non-Prop G calendars. The non-Prop G (Outlook) calendar entries were previously withheld in their entirety, and were clearly public with only specific redactions, thus Respondents violated SFAC 67.26 for non-minimal withholding and/or SFAC 67.21 for providing an incomplete response. *See SOTF 19047, and Sup. of Records letter of Sept 6.*

D. In addition, they have also (after the filing of the complaint) provided lists of justifications (with clear reference to most, but not all, redactions). The following are examples of improper redactions or withholdings, in most cases where the law cited does not actually exempt the information withheld (SFAC 67.26/67.27), which should all be determined public parts of records and ordered disclosed. Furthermore, if you find that the information is exempt BUT Respondents used a false justification, that would still be a SFAC 67.26/67.27 violation, but you would not need to order it disclosed.

1. Once formerly-future dates had passed, entries were withheld/redacted using Admin Code 67.29-5(b) and Admin Code 67.29-5(e), which are not exemptions at all. Whatever records are being withheld under these must be produced.

Page numbers below refer to [linked] Nov. 5 production entitled "P9438 - responsive 3.pdf". Purported exemption reasons are taken from p. 1, of that document.

2. Pg. 39-41 - GC6254(f) - these redactions are completely wrong. I have received a copy of a similar record from the Mayor's Office/Sean Elsbernd as well, with far fewer redactions. On that basis, I assert that a portion of this redacted record is unlawfully withheld. I suspect a large portion of the redacted portion of record looks like **Exhibit A**, which is an excerpt from Elsbernd's similar, public record.
3. pp.12-13, GC6254(c) - Sept 30, 2019 - 3:30pm - names of employees at RSA and SF Travel
4. Pg. 17 - GC6254(c) has no relevance to this redaction mark
5. Pg. 18, 19 - GC6254(c) cannot exempt Chief Scott's government email address
6. Pg. 25 - GC6254(f) - how is the title of this meeting a security procedure, intelligence or investigation information? "Law enforcement sensitive" is not the actual exemption in the law.
7. Pg. 27 - GC6254(c) and 6254(f) - there are multiple redactions on this page. Which redaction has which justification? Also, I challenge the redactions - this is a business trying to sell or work with SFPD on something, not a personal issue - it should be released.
8. Pg. 36-37 - GC6254(c) and 6254(f) - there are multiple redactions on this page. Which redaction has which justification?
9. Pg. 36 - 9am redacted without any justification
10. Pg. 57 - community barbeque information redacted as 6254(f) law enforcement sensitive. Is this a security procedure, investigation, or intelligence information?
11. Pg. 63-71 - all redactions challenged. Names and email addresses of government employees are not secret. Names of businesses and employees doing business with the city are not secret. Descriptions of Fleet Week are not secret.
12. Pg. 78-79 - GC6254(c), GC6254(f), PC 832.7. there are multiple redactions on this page. Which redaction has which justification? All redactions challenged. Various email bodies are inside this meeting entry, all government employee names/email addresses, and the topics of discussion should be unredacted.
13. Pg. 94-96 - GC6254(c) and 6254(f) - there are multiple redactions on this page. Which redaction has which justification? Regardless, Govt email addresses should be provided for AGZoneMeeting and Genesis Coronado. Govt office phone number for Coronado must also be provided. The full Agenda of this meeting between public officials should also be provided - 2 lines were redacted.

14. Pg. 102 - GC6254(c) - this is a public official (Commissioner Taylor) apparently using their personal email address for government business. See Govt Code 6254.3(b)(1) for special provisions re: disclosure of such email address.
15. Pg. 113 - Individual record entries for each of the three 10am meetings were withheld without justification. If these records were deleted by SFPD after I made my request but before they produced records for me, we will further allege an incomplete response, which can no longer be cured. Whether Chief Scott participated in a meeting is irrelevant to whether a public record exists. The record clearly exists since it is on his summary view and must be disclosed.
16. Pg. 118 - this 4pm meeting has no justifications for any redactions. All the redactions are unlawful and must be disclosed.
17. Pg. 124 - Individual record entries for each of the 10am, 1pm, and 3pm meetings were withheld without justification. If these records were deleted by SFPD after I made my request but before they produced records for me, we will further allege an incomplete response, which can no longer be cured. Whether Chief Scott participated in a meeting is irrelevant to whether a public record exists. The record clearly exists since it is on his summary view and must be disclosed.

PROPOSED COMPROMISE

I will withdraw¹ the allegation of 67.21 violation of this complaint 19112, if Respondent Chief Scott agrees in a letter signed by him, to myself and the SOTF, and copied to the Police Commission, published² in the public record, on behalf of himself and the SFPD that:

- (1) all of Scott's and SFPD's calendar records, for dates in the future and/or past, whether Prop G (SFAC 67.29-5) or non-Prop G, are public records and must be disclosed if such records exist at the time of a records request, except for redactions for explicitly exempt information, and
- (2) disclosure of Scott's Prop G (SFAC 67.29-5) calendars cannot be delayed for 3 business days until after the date of the calendar entry, *if such records already exist at the time of a records request.*

The letter must be from and signed by Chief Scott himself as it is his calendars at issue. Unfortunately, the 67.26/67.27 allegations remain because some of the records produced have been redacted using exemptions that do not apply to the information redacted (see Part D above). However, if the above letter is provided and Respondents fix the redactions in Part D to my satisfaction, I can withdraw the entire complaint.



Andrew Cox and the Police Department. Specifically, I was asked by the committee if SFPD would release future Prop. G calendars upon request and I answered yes. I apologize for causing confusion. When I provided that answer, I did not mean to infer that SFPD would waive any rights to exempt Prop. G calendars in whole or any portion thereof if warranted. We continue to apply exemptions and exceptions to the Chief's future calendar entries that have not yet occurred under Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(f); Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(k); Cal. Evid. Code. § 1040; Times Mirror Company v. Superior Court, 53 Cal.3d 1325 (1991).

Chief Scott is the head Law Enforcement Official for the City and County of San Francisco, which carries a higher risk to his personal safety. His job presents unique security risks that requires unique security procedures and protocols to ensure his safety. Releasing information from his calendar reveals the timing and details of his whereabouts as well as the patterns and habits of the Chief of Police. While we are cautious to release his calendar at all under the laws cited above, we have done so after a careful review of events that have occurred in the past and redact information according to the cites listed above. However, this careful review may only be done by looking back at events that have already occurred. Releasing future calendar entries presents a new set of security issues.

Releasing future calendar entries inherently increases the risk to his security. This would seriously impair the ability of the Department to assure his personal safety and it would constitute a potential threat to his safety because this information would enable a reader to know in advance and with relative precision when and where the Chief may be found, the timing of his departures and arrivals from events or locations. In addition, the reader would know the persons who will be with him, and when he will be alone. We have redacted past Prop. G calendars entries under Cal. Govt Code section 6254(f) Cal. Gov't Code § 6254(k); Cal. Evid. Code. § 1040; Times Mirror Company v. Superior Court, 53 Cal.3d 1325 (1991).SFPD has never produced future Prop. G calendars in the past.

In retrospect, I understand that I answered the question poorly and I should have elaborated on our position. I sincerely apologize for any confusion and did not mean to mislead the committee and/or Anonymous. My statement to the committee was of my own volition and should not reflect any misconduct by Chief Scott or the SFPD.

The San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) received your Public Records Act request, dated September 06, 2020, on September 08, 2020.

*You requested, "SFPD and Lt. Cox, On Sept. 2, 2020, in SOTF 19112 Anonymous v. Scott, et al., SOTF found a violation by SFPD of, inter alia, SFAC 67.26 for not providing future/prospective calendars for Chief Scott at all (instead of with minimal redactions) and SFAC 67.27 for citing Prop G for withholding non-Prop G calendars. Lt. Cox also appeared to state that SFPD had changed its own position re: disclosure policies of calendars to properly disclose future and non-Prop G calendars, notwithstanding the position of the City Attorney's office. Therefore, this is an immediate disclosure request for all calendars/schedule records (with all meeting details in Outlook or anywhere else, including all attachments and metadata) for Chief William Scott (both Prop G and non-Prop G) for (a) Oct 1 through Oct 14, 2020 as the schedule exists at this time and (b) Aug 24-Sep 1, 2020 (all dates inclusive). Pursuant to SFAC 67.21(l) and SOTF 19047, please provide the records in PDF format *without* printing and scanning. Also, you mentioned that you had created a specific email address for records requests - could you please indicate what that email is? I am aware of sfpdlegal@sfgov.org and sfpdmediarelations@sfgov.org. (There are various, independent, anonymous requesters who use MuckRock - so I cannot control what the other users do, but I am happy to request MuckRock use a different email address for SFPD if it will work better.)"*

The immediate disclosure process is for requests that are "simple, routine or otherwise readily answerable." Please see San Francisco Administrative Code section 67.25(a). Your request is not simple or routine. The maximum deadline for responding to a request applies. The Department is looking into your request and will provide you with a response within 10 calendar days but no later than by September 18, 2020. Please refer to California Government Code Section 6253(c).

Dear Sunshine Ordinance Task Force:

The San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) is in receipt of the Complaint filed by Anonymous with the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force (SOTF) alleging that SFPD violated Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Sections 67.21, 67.26, 67.27, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner, failing to respond to a public records request in a timely and/or complete manner, failing to justify withholding of records and failing to maintain a Proposition G calendar.

The SFPD takes responsibility for not providing a response to the requestor within the required time frame. The October 8, 2019 Public Records request was submitted to the Department via email to an email account that is not used by the Department for public records requests. The Department has a process for public records requests. The Unit that monitors that account forwarded the request to the appropriate division on October 15, 2019. The request was made as an Immediate Disclosure request. The immediate disclosure process is for requests that are "simple, routine or otherwise readily answerable." Please see San Francisco Administrative Code section 67.25(a). This request was not simple, routine or otherwise readily available. On October 16, 2019 we acknowledged that the request was received on October 15, 2019 and informed the requestor that the 10 day maximum deadline to respond applies. Please refer to California Government Code Section 6253(c).

On October 23, 2019 and October 29, 2019 the SFPD provided the requestor with responsive records and included specific justifications as to why certain information was not disclosed in our response letters. On October 30, 2019, we reviewed the basis for the complaint and determined there was a miscommunication. The SFPD supplemented its production on Nov 5, 2019 and provided additional information. The SFPD has withheld certain information based on Cal. Govt. Sec. 6254(f) and Evidence Code 1040 as the information presents a security risk for the Chief of Police. Furthermore, redactions have also been made in these materials of personal information on the basis of privacy, pursuant to Section 6254(c) of the Public Records Act (California Government Code sec. 6254(c)) and Article I, sec. 1 of the California Constitution because disclosure of this information would constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy and Penal Code Sec. 832.7 (Peace Officer personnel records).
