13	WHEREAS, The event will encourage civic engagement in the city of San Francisco
14	through speakers, activities, and information sessions; and,
15	WHEREAS, The youth of San Francisco need an event like this so that they can be
16	comfortable around law enforcement, thereby enabling more communication between law
17	enforcement and the public; and,
18	WHEREAS, The number of juvenile arrest rates per 100,000 people in San Francisco
19	is nearly two and half times that of the state of California; and, <sup>2</sup>
20	WHEREAS, Members of the Berkeley and Oakland Youth Commissions are also
21	involved in the event and endorse it; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Youth Commission endorses the aforementioned
23	2011 Know Your Rights event to be held at Lick-Wilmerding High School.
