This year the young leaders of TAYSF's Citywide TAY Advisory Board (CTAB) launched a work group to take proactive action on an issue of most importance to the young people themselves. They chose to focus on increasing workforce development and paid employment opportunities for undocumented youth!

The main goals are:

- Host a training to share some of the effective practices currently utilized by service providers to pay undocumented youth for the broader field
- Double the amount of paid employment opportunities for undocumented youth in the summer of 2015
- Make the current pilot program investment from the city permanent and year round

We are now asking the SF Youth Commission to partner with TAYSF's young leaders and community allies by co-sponsoring the training. Co-sponsoring would mean supporting the effort through outreach with your networks and encouraging SF direct service providers to attend as well. If agreed to we would put the SF Youth Commission logo on all outreach materials and acknowledge the SF Youth Commission at the training itself.
