#### 1. Call to Order and Roll Call

A. Review and update Campaign Action Plan and Timeline

#### B. Environmental Education Survey

Commissioner Tam shared that she is currently working on a resolution to urge DCYF to include environmental education for you into its curriculum for grantee organizations. Commissioner Tam is first however working on a survey to establish an understanding of young people's knowledge and opinions of sorting waste.

Committee members shared their thoughts and feedback on the survey, mostly encouraging commissioner Tam to rephrase a few open ended questions to include options. Staff updated the survey to reflect the changes. Commission Tam asked the committee to help with distributing the survey in their networks, to which her colleagues agreed. There was no public comment.

### C. Updates on legislation at the Board of Supervisors relevant to the committee
