- BJC is a coalition of coalitions: 42 groups & networks working to make the SF City Budget more accessible. Budgets are moral documents.



2022 Budget Timeline

- December: Mayor's Budget Instructions
- January-February: Commission Hearings
- March-May: Mayor's Office Budget Adjustments
- June 1st: Mayor's Proposed Budget Released
- June: Board of Supervisors Budget Committee hearings and deliberations
- July: Board of Supervisor vote on Final Budget

Budget 101

- SF has a large City Budget 13 billion dollars
 - scale: used to be 6 billion dollars
 - double the size of the City of Philly's budget
 - one thing to remember: **don't let anyone tell you there isn't any money to do things.**
 - this is the 1st time that the City expects a surplus since 1986
 - SF needs to have a balanced budget
- The SF Charter gives the Mayor a lot of power. The Mayor works on the budget for 10 months and BOS has 2 months.
