Commissioner Barker Plummer reads the resolution out loud for the Committee.

Public Commenter, Leo V., asks about in the case of school shootings, how does the MOU work? Commissioner Barker Plummer responds. The Public Commenter states that the Commission should talk to public school students and get their opinions.

Commissioner Pimentel asks if this will be expanded into a bigger resolution in the future. Commissioner Barker Plummer hopes that this has enough information to push forward.
