a. Community Builder

Task Force participated in answering the following question: "What is something overrated?".

b. Legislative Priorities for the LGBTQ+ Task Force - Recap

Director Garcia reviews the legislative priorities that the Task Force talked about from the last meeting. Chair Stack Lozano talks about the recent outing of students in SFUSD.



Member Rafer asks if it's within the jurisdiction to write a resolution about the misinformation regarding Israel and the LGBTQ+ community.

c. Previous LGBTQ+ Task Force Projects

Director Garcia talks about the previous LGBTQ+ Task Force projects from the year 2022-2023. Previous task force members bring up the work from last year.

d. LGBTQ+ Task Force Related Updates

Vice Chair Alioto-Pier asks the Task Force for concrete action items for the year. The Task Force wants to continue to focus on youth homelessness. Commissioner Barker Plummer wants to look at state legislation that is related to sex education and homelessness. Member Rafer asks about focusing on housing vacancies and filling in the vacancies to house queer people. Director Garcia asks the Task Force to see if the Task Force can get an update from the SF LGBTQ Coalition because they received their funding from the last budget cycle. Vice Chair Alioto-Pier asks for a review of the sex education BPP. Member Rafer provides an overview. Chair Stack Lozano asks the Task Force to review the BPPs from last year.

Vice Chair Alioto-Pier asks about goal-setting. Member Rafer asks the Task Force to write a resolution to be referred to the Full Commission to support a ceasefire, especially around the propaganda of pink-washing. Member Rafer clarifies that it'd be a support statement for the BOS resolution.

Chair Stack Lozano asks for a presentation from the LGBTQ Coalition. Member Tao asks about a presentation from the SFUSD QTAC. The Committee discusses a potential resolution to ask for LGBTQ representation in schools. Commissioner Barker Plummer recommends partnering with SFPL for this topic. Director Garcia suggests reaching out to LGBTQ-serving organizations.

6. Staff Report (discussion item)

Director Garcia will be sending a presentation list to the Task Force. The next meeting is February 29th, 2024. The Task Force discusses the frequency of task force meetings and will decide offline.
