6	WHEREAS, Students from middle class families are often overlooked, and have the most
7	difficulty paying for college; and,
8	WHEREAS, Students from higher income families can often afford to cover the tuition and fees
9	for colleges, while students from lower income families can qualify for more financial aid and grants;
10	and,
11	WHEREAS, Many middle class students rely on student loans to pay for their tuitions, and
12	many of them finish school in debt; and,
13	WHEREAS, Some middle class students cannot afford to pay for college, and eventually give
14	up on obtaining a higher education; and,
15	WHEREAS, The Middle Class Scholarship Plan will allow students from middle class families
16	to attend a University of California, California State University, or community college at a lower cost,
17	ensuring that their families can save more money; and,
18	WHEREAS, Tuition and fees for college would be cut down by two-thirds for middle class
19	students in the UC and CSU system; and,
20	WHEREAS, the Middle Class Scholarship Act would save UC students about \$8,200 a year
21	and CSU students about \$4,000 a year; ¹ and,
22	WHEREAS, \$150 million would be set aside for Community Colleges to make THEM
23	affordable; and,

9	higher education more accessible to middle class students.
