4 Shall the Youth Commission support TAYSF's SF4TAY resource website by helping with
5 outreach and shall the Youth Commission cosponsor the SF4TAY resource website launch
6 event in June 2012?

8 Supplemental information
9 The 2006 Transitional Youth Task Force identified the need to increase outreach and
10 awareness efforts to better connect transitional age youth with existing programs and
11 services. There are few access points that advertise or refer youth to multiple services. TAY
12 and service providers often have a hard time finding resources because they are not in one
13 comprehensive place. Printed guides often become outdated as soon as they are printed, as
14 CBOs or programs may move, change contact information, or go out of business. Current
15 guides and websites often do not contain resources specifically designed for TAY. A TAY only
16 website is needed to maximize the resources that exist in the community.

18 SF4TAY.org will be a comprehensive, one stop access and referral TAY resource website
19 specifically for TAY and their supporters. This searchable resource directory will allow young
20 adults to easily access information in order to connect with the range of local resources that
21 are available to them. Services in workforce, education, housing, wellness, advocacy and
22 recreation will be listed on one central site. The SF4TAY.org site will go live during a launch
23 event in June 2012.
