3	On February 24, 2016, the Associated Student Inc. at San Francisco State University adopted a resolution in support of the College of Ethic Studies. The resolution calls attention unique history, and positive impact the college has had on the students of San Francisco State University since it was created. The first college of its kind, the college of ethnic studies at SFSU was created as a result of the organizing efforts of 1968 coalition of students of color and other organizations in response to the lack of culturally sensitive and culturally relevant course on the campus at the time.  The resolution also brings attention to the increasing number of budget cuts experienced by the college, most notably occurring in 2008. Today, the College of Ethnic Studies has been targeted by the SFSU Administration for another round of budget cuts. If the proposed cuts were made, it will effectively decimate the college.
