WHEREAS, The Mix opened in June 2015, it is a 4,770-square-foot dedicated teen only digital media center and learning lab located within the San Francisco Public Library Main Branch, and

WHEREAS, The Mix is the first-of-its-kind teen center in California that provides teens with advanced technological equipment to use and programs to attend, and

WHEREAS, "It is a space for teens from 13 to 18 years old to hang out, mess around, and geek out" 1, and

WHEREAS, teens who regularly visit The Mix have positive comments about the space and;

WHEREAS, "[The MIX] is a nice place for relaxing and making friends."2, and

WHEREAS, "[The Mix] is an innovative and relaxing space. It's very fun and has a lot of resources, ³

WHEREAS, It has a state-of-the-art recording studio, a high quality video production space, a "makerspace" that contains many top quality fabrication technologies such as a 3D printer and a laser cutter, a "carpet garden" which is an area for teens to socialize with friends located in view of the projection screen, and an interactive touch-screen wall and;

WHEREAS, The Mix has reached over 19,000 visitors as of December 2015, has 478 registered members, and has held 199 programs, including YouthSpeaks, a series of creative writing
