4	WHEREAS, The Young Performers Theatre (YPT) is a non-profit theater in San
5	Francisco with programming and opportunities for youth; and
6	WHEREAS, YPT was founded in 1983 by Matilda Manning Kunin, in memory of
7	her son Anthony Manning Kunin, to provide theatrical instruction for kids as well as
8	entertainment the entire family could experience together; and
9	WHEREAS, YPT's mission is "to provide every child in the Bay Area with the
10	opportunity to tell their stories and participate in theater, with the aim of instilling a life-
11	long appreciation of the arts; providing a safe, supportive space for social bonding; and
12	fostering the skills necessary to succeed in life including self-confidence, empathy,
13	focus, teamwork and creative thinking to solve problems"; and
14	WHEREAS, Since its founding, YPT has provided hundreds of young people with
15	the opportunity to learn about themselves and grow as people through the performing
16	arts; and
17	WHEREAS, Since its founding, YPT has presented over 150 shows and
18	developed a rich toolkit for improving outcomes in early childhood development through
19	its multiple programs; and
20	WHEREAS, YPT's Theatre in Education program, which is supported by the
21	Mimi and Peter Haas Fund, provides arts-based enrichment curricula to seven Haas-
22	funded family centers and model preschools in low-income neighborhoods around San
23	Francisco; and

1	WHEREAS, YPT's Theatre in Education program teaches youth key life skills,
2	including creative problem solving, group coordination, empathy for other points of view,
3	thinking around what makes a story, and how to respond to cues appropriately; and
4	WHEREAS, YPT's Repertory program provides a space for young performers to
5	work together to create and produce full-scale productions free of charge, with
6	performances being open to the public; and
7	WHEREAS, YPT's Repertory program builds the confidence of youth who
8	participate in the Repertory both in and outside the theater; and
9	WHEREAS, YPT's Academy program teaches youth the fundamentals of
10	dramatization and story structure, and teaches acting, performance, musical theater,
11	stagecraft and production skills; and therefore be it
12	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Youth Commission hereby commends the
13	work of the Young Performers Theatre and recognizes the positive impact the
14	community and its programs have had on youth in the City and County of San
15	Francisco.
